

SHOULD I WORK IN A LAB OR WITH A PROFESSOR?

PROFESSOR

- Focus is usually on writing
- Easier to find for non-STEM related projects
- Less time commitment
- Less experience needed
- Get less experience out of it
- You can still present to associations, get authorship, use data
- Good for LOR

LAB

- Focus is usually on doing
- Will often require at least 10 hours per week
- Many STEM-related labs need help
- May be able to get paid (but prepare to be exploited)
- More of a learning curve but will get more direct experience
- Work with non-teaching staff
